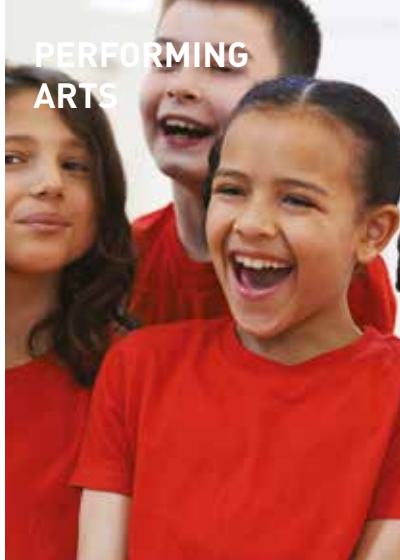

FAMILY FUN 5-11 YEAR OLDS

THIS EASTER WE HAVE A WIDE RANGE OF FREE EXCITING INCLUSIVE ACTIVITIES ACROSS THE BOROUGH AVAILABLE FOR YOU TO ENJOY WITH YOUR FAMILY. THE SESSIONS WILL PROVIDE OPPORTUNITIES FOR CHILDREN AGED 5 -11 TO TRY NEW ACTIVITIES AND LEARN NEW SKILLS, WHILST HAVING FUN AND MAKING NEW FRIENDS.

All sessions are led by Waltham Forest Play Workers, with specialist workshops provided by professionals from a variety of local organisations. Most activities run for 45 minutes to enable all children to be able to try everything on offer during each session, and allow families to join at any time throughout the session.

Activities that are provided throughout these sessions are suitable and designed for children aged 5 – 11. Children aged under 5 may attend if they have older siblings.

Children aged 5 – 7 must be accompanied by an adult throughout the sessions. Children aged 8 – 11 may attend the session independently, however a parent, guardian or carer must attend the first session to complete the relevant paperwork.

Activities that are taking place during Easter include:

Leyton Orient Football – Multi Sports

Leyton Orient coaches will provide a multi-sport programme in which children can play sports including athletics, netball, basketball, uni hockey and football.

Bollyfusion

BollyFusion is an exciting and innovative dance session for children. It is an exciting combination of movement from Bollywood, classical Indian, hip hop and jazz forms.

Salsa

Salsa is a popular form of social dance with strong influences from Latin America, particularly Cuba and Puerto Rico. The movements of salsa are rhythmical and upbeat and can be done in pairs or individually, which is fun for any age group.

Face Painting

Come and have your face painted by a local expert face painter.

Balloon Science

Balloons are fun, right? Well if balloons are fun then that must mean that science is fun!

The Balloon science show is full of spills, thrills explosions and pops!

Recycled Art

Participants will get the chance to use found objects and recycled materials to create pieces of art.

Street Dance

Street Dance is a fun and exciting mix of Hip Hop, Locking, Popping and Waving.

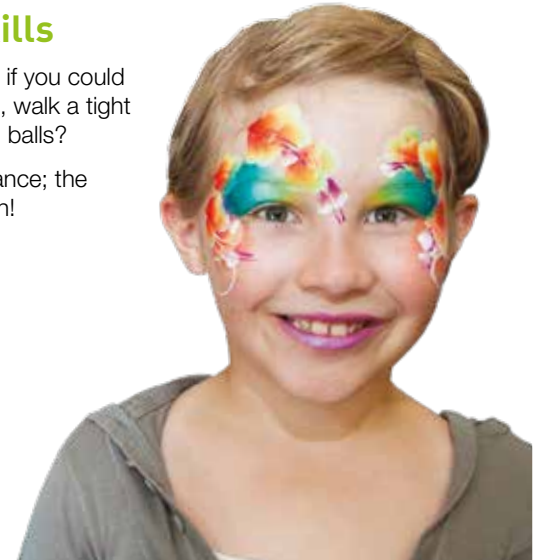
African Drumming

Little Angel Theatre will be running drop-in sessions where participants can make their own crazy creature or mad monster glove puppet. Using your own whacky ideas you will design, make and decorate a puppet to take home!



Aladdin Theatre Workshop

Step inside a “whole new world” and discover the magic that lies within the genies lamp! Join Dolly Dimples on Aladdin’s journey from a Street Rat to a Prince!

During the session you will make and decorate your own magical lamps before embarking on a magical journey full of games, dancing and acting.

Moana Workshop

Come and join Dolly Dimples on the daring mission to help Moana save her people and put the Island of Te Fiti back together again. We will need to find Maui (a once Demi God) to complete the quest! We need to be brave as will encounter many monsters and impossible odds.
